(During this time he also began playing mandolin, banjo and bass as well.) Through the years he has toured with various groups playing throughout the US, Fiji, Australia & New Zealand. Influences range from James Taylor to Earl Klugh and from Stevie Ray Vaughn to Larry Carlton.



Jeff Janssen | Drums

Jeff is an introvert with very noisy vocations. He has been playing drums and percussion (and moving equipment) since 1969. His mother said he should play the flute: "Even the tuba player only has one case!"

As a student of music as an art form, he's played in symphony orchestras, big bands, brass ensembles, polka bands, musical stage productions, funk/dance bands, rock party cover bands, and blues jams throughout the West Coast.
